

## CONDITIONS OF RENTAL

1. The customer takes full responsibility for the safe custody of equipment from the time it is collected from, or delivered by, Photo-Sonics International Ltd. to the time it is returned to, or collected by, Photo-Sonics International Ltd. The Title to the equipment remains with Photo-Sonics International Ltd. at all times.
2. The customer accepts responsibility for:
  - a. Insuring the equipment against all risks, including those arising from transit, storage and exhibition, to its full value for the full rental period.
  - b. Insuring against Third Party and Public Liability risks while the equipment is in its care and being used by it.
3. The customer will provide suitable transport and packing material for collection and return of the equipment unless Photo-Sonics International Ltd undertakes collection and return. Photo-Sonics International Ltd reserves the right to refuse an otherwise agreed rental if the customer, when collecting the equipment, arrives with transport and/or packing considered unsuitable by Photo-Sonics International Ltd. Although Photo-Sonics International Ltd. takes no responsibility for any loss occurring as a result of its approval of or failure to disapprove transport and/or packing, which are deemed to be unsuitable.
4. Photo-Sonics International Ltd. reserves the right to charge for Service Engineer's travel and on-site costs at the current rate when installing or dismantling the equipment, when such installation or dismantling is requested by the customer or is deemed necessary by Photo-Sonics International Ltd.
5. The customer agrees to maintain the equipment in good condition and to indemnify Photo-Sonics International Ltd against all repairs, replacement and other costs if the equipment is damaged during the rental period.
6. If, in the event of equipment failure during the rental period, the customer required on-site repair, Photo-Sonics International Ltd. reserves the right to charge for travel and labour costs. If, in such an event, (which excludes any such damage as is referred to in paragraph 5), the customer returns the equipment to Photo-Sonics International Ltd.'s Service Centre, the repair will not be charged for.
7. The customer agrees not to tamper in any way with the equipment other than by way of adjustment of external controls and further agrees to comply strictly with all instructions and operating manuals supplied by Photo-Sonics International Ltd. relating to the equipment.
8. Unless the customer notifies Photo-Sonics International Ltd. of any defect in the equipment within three days after its collection, the equipment will be deemed to have been in good working order and condition at the time of its collection.
9. It is expressly forbidden that Equipment Loaned or Rented by Photo-Sonics International Ltd is re-rented to a third party in any manner without the express written permission from a Director of Photo-Sonics International Ltd.
